

At a called meeting of St
George's Benevolent Society
held in St Georges Church
Tuesday Evening June 23rd 18
Rev E C Muddough D D in
Chair the minutes of the last
meeting were read and approved
No meeting having been held on
the Lord Tuesday Evening the 9th to
which meeting the Committee
appointed to frame a Constitution
were directed to report

Committee reported the following
Constitution

Article I

The name of this Society shall
St Georges Benevolent Society
Fredericksburg

Article II

The objects of this Society shall be
to promote true religion & aid
the poor of the Town of Fredericks
to receive and hold all donations

(Last Line)

and bequests made for that purpose

and as it may appear convenient and proper - to more effectually carry out its objects. Out of the Contributions of its members and donations and bequests made to it from time to time to establish asylums for poor aged persons widows or orphans reformatories or schools and support and manage the same

Article III

The members of this Society shall consist of all males and females of St George's Congregation who have signed or may sign the Constitutions of the male and female St George's Church Societies. Shall be members of this Society which shall consist of two branches a male and female which shall conduct their work as it has been conducted hitherto by the male and female St George's Church Societies whose Constitutions shall have full force and effect except so far as the same are inconsistent with this Constitution

Either branch of the Society may call a joint meeting on ten days notice to the other branch

Article IV

The officers of this Society shall be a President "Ex Officio" The Rector of St George's Church Three male and three female Vice Presidents Viz: 1st 2nd & 3rd male & 1st 2nd & 3rd female which shall be the present President and the 1st & 2nd Vice Presidents of St George's Church Societies male & female now branches of this St George's Benevolent Society of Fredericktown A Secretary the Secretary of the male branch of this Society and Treasurer the Treasurer of the male branch of this Society
Section 2 - It shall be the duty of the President to preside over all the meetings of this Society when present and in the absence of the President it shall be the duty of one of the Male Vice Presidents to preside over the meetings of this Society

Section 3rd = It shall be the duty of the Secretary to keep a record of all the proceedings of this Society and take charge of its Correspondence and all books and papers

Section = 4th It shall be the duty of the Treasurer to take charge of all the rents, incomes and contributions of the Society and to disburse the same on the written order of the President or the 1st Male or 1st Female Vice Presidents

Section = 5 Eight members of this Society shall constitute a quorum

Section = 6 It shall require three fourths of the members present to change this Constitution and thirty days notice
