The undersigned Committee composed
of A. W. Wallace W. M. Braxton Mrs
Chas E Lockett appointed at the meeting
of the Benevolent Society held on
February 13th 1922 to formulate
rules and regulations for the Society in
lieu of the missing by-laws and
to formulate changes and amendments
to the constitution respectfully report
to the Society that they had a
meeting on April 19th 1922 and
report that the constitution needs
only the following amendments
Namely.

Article III shall read.

The members of this Society
shall consist of all Communions
for the time being of Saint
Georges Church and this
article so far as the qualification
of members is concerned
to be considered retroactive
as validating all acts at
meetings in which members
of Saint Georges Church
took part whether qualified
otherwise or not

Article IV shall read
sect one

The Rector of Saint George's Church shall be ex officio President of this Society and there shall be three male Vice Presidents and three female Vice Presidents known respectively as First Vice President, second Vice President and Third Vice President, a Secretary and a Treasurer, and such Committees as may be appointed from time to time at the meetings of the Society which shall be held on the first day of July and January of each year and at any other time when called by the Rector or any of the Vice Presidents of the Society.

The committee further recommends and reports that the original charter and the constitution as amended will be sufficient in the way of rules and regulations

to govern the affairs of the
Society and therefore think there
is no occasion for any further
By-Laws to be formulated but that
Section 7 of article IV of the Constitution
shall be added to said article.
The Society is authorized from
time to time to pass if it deem
necessary any further rules
and regulations to govern its
action and the proceedings. She
be governed by the general parliamentary
law all of which is respectfully
reported for adoption.
