1. Change in worship schedule beginning September 12, 1976.

In accordance with our diverse needs, interests and tastes and in accordance with the liturgical movement abroad in our church, we shall begin the following schedule on Sundays.

- A. 8 A.M. Holy Communion 1928 Prayer Book  
No sermon but brief comment on The Gospel of the Day
- B. 9:30 A.M. Contemporary Service of Holy Communion  
using Rite II of the Authorized Services (1973)  
otherwise known as The Zebra Book.  
Informal service and setting, dress optional  
Sermon by Rector.
- C. 11 A. M. Traditional Service 1928 Prayer Book  
Holy Communion 1st and 3rd Sundays  
Morning Prayer all other Sundays  
Sermon by Rector at all services
- D. Midweek Service 7:30 Wednesday Varied service type
- E. Christian Education

We believe in the idea that learning to worship is an essential part of Christian Education. Therefore, we ask parents to worship with their school age children at one of our services.

- 1. Come to the 9:30 service. Children go out after the first communion rail for refreshments downstairs. Church School classes run from 10:30 to 11:00 A.M.
  - a. Adults and teenagers during this time are invited to coffee, donuts and orange juice in the Family Room or to view good films on faith and life in the Senior Citizens Room. Topics and descriptions of films will be published in advance.
- 2. Come to the 11:00 A.M. service at 10:30 for your children and until 11:00 A.M. join in the above activities with other adults from the 9:30 service.

Begins September 15th.

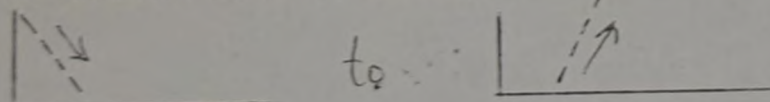
Followed by various 4 or 6 week blocks during the
